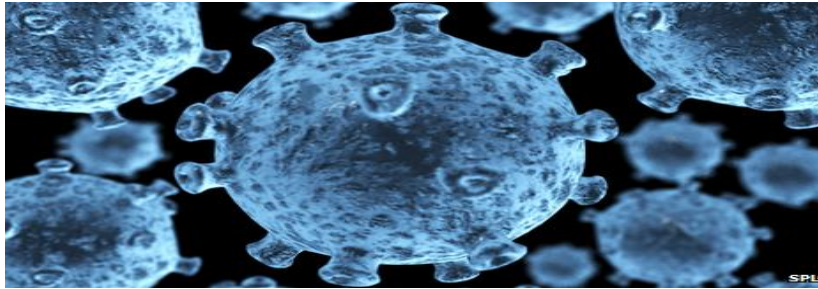




Sexual Health/HIV Treatment & Care: A nursing perspective
